A family of four living in a very “crooked” home that is over 100 years old. The roof leaks, the porch is rotten and numerous other problems with their home. They make less than \$900 a month.

Approximately 60-70 middle-class kids whose families can afford to send them to a week-long day camp at a very nice, modern YMCA.

What possibly could these two groups of people have in common?

They both need Jesus!

Yes, that’s why we go. This past July 3-8, MBA sent 18 people representing 8 churches to work with Ocoee Outreach in Cleveland, Tennessee. We slept in a church and ate meals prepared by local churches. We worked long, hard, hot days and had lots of fun fellowshiping with each other.

We divided our group into two teams. One group replaced the porch, rebuilt the entire front half of the rafter system, and installed a brand new metal roof. We fell through the rafters twice along the way! We interacted with the home owners and shared with them about God’s love. We’re currently working on finding them regular transportation to church.

The other team became in essence a pilot project working with the kids at the Y’s day camp. They played games, brought biblical devotions, organized crafts, and generally interacted with the kids and administration at the YMCA. It was received so well, they want to expand our efforts next year.

Missions – I just love it.

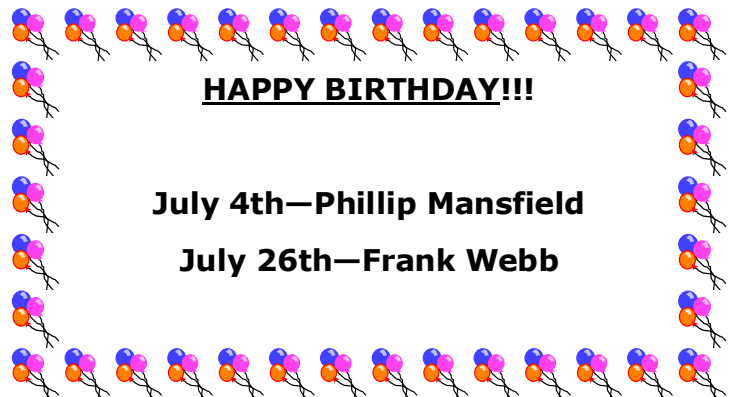

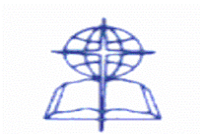
